

ATTENDANCE IS MANDATORY

The summer semester is comprised of 25 instructional days and 2 examination days. Eastern Suffolk BOCES requires that attendance be in accordance with the policy set at each individual site. Credit may not be granted if absences exceed three days.

Lateness, up to 15 minutes, counts as half an absence; lateness of more than 15 minutes counts as a full absence. The actual granting of credit must be made by the student's home school.

STUDENT REGULATIONS

- Smoking is prohibited anywhere in the school building or on school grounds.
- Clothing must be school appropriate and not distract from or interfere with teaching and learning.
- Parking is permitted in designated areas only. Junior license operators are not permitted to drive to summer school.
- Students will be dismissed from the program for inappropriate behavior.
- Use of cell phones, pagers, and any other type of electronic devices will be strictly prohibited during summer school hours.

SUPPORT SERVICES

Individual IEPs must be provided by parent/guardian during summer school registration. Students who experience course difficulty are encouraged to confer with teachers and the principal as soon as possible.

TRANSPORTATION

Transportation to and from summer school is not provided by Eastern Suffolk BOCES.

TUITION PAYMENTS

- Payment must be made by money order or bank check. Personal checks and cash will not be accepted.
- Students in Non-Participating Districts, please see the Summer School Administrators at the Registration site for tuition rates.
- Classes with less than 10 students will not run.
- Students from Non-Participating Districts enrolling in classes of 10-14 students will be assessed a surcharge. Please see Summer School Administrators at the Registration site for details.
- NO REFUNDS will be made for classes, Regents or RCTs for any reason, other than cancellation due to insufficient registration.

NOTE: Students taking the Regents or RCT exams are encouraged to take the Regents Review course. Experience shows a much higher percentage of students pass the exams when they take the course. Purchase of Review Books may be required.

Instruction is designed to provide opportunities for students to succeed with previously attempted course work. A report card for all coursework, Regents, and RCT grades will be sent home to each student. ***Due to confidentiality, grades will not be given over the phone.***

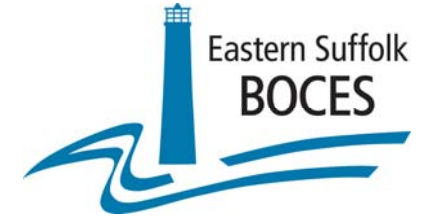
