Did you know that you can access Model Schools professional development courses by using MyLearningPlan? This web-based service allows districts to grant access to teachers for available professional development courses.

Two ways to view Model Schools information:

District access:

To enable the visibility of an ESBOCES catalog go to the “Configuration” area of the district site (Program Admin tab) and add ESBOCES as a system provider catalog.
