MOUSE Squad Training

MOUSE Squad is a standards-based program that prepares and supports teams of teachers and students to establish and sustain technical support help desks in their schools. Operating as an after-school club, extra-curricular activity or as part of an already existing class or course, the program improves a school's capacity to integrate technology into teaching and learning and creates a powerful, hands-on 21st century learning experience for students.

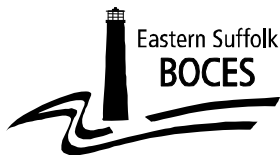


MOUSE Squad Provides Service for the School:

- Student help desk technicians work with the school technician or technology coordinator to answer technical support requests for service around the school.
- MOUSE Squad technicians conduct weekly routine maintenance, operate as computer lab assistants and undertake special projects.
- MOUSE Squads reduce the school's technical support costs.

MOUSE Squad e-Learning Highlights:

- **MOUSE Squad Faculty Advisor(s):** Teachers manage a student team that answers technical support queries. Faculty advisors are invited to receive pre-service hands-on training and MOUSE Squad e-learning to learn how to set up and run a technical support help desk.
- **Leadership and Technical Skills:** Students learn problem solving, teamwork, data analysis, customer service/client relations, computer troubleshooting, communication, Information Computing Technology (ICT) literacy, leadership ability and other skills.
- **Data Collection System:** Student technicians capture and analyze data related to the work completed by the squad.
- **Ongoing Support:** MOUSE provides access to e-learning, yearly awards and incentives, bi-weekly e-mail updates, an annual national conference and more.
- **MOUSECORPS:** High school students may apply to participate in this youth development program designed to build hip and career readiness skills through experiential learning projects and industry shadowships.
