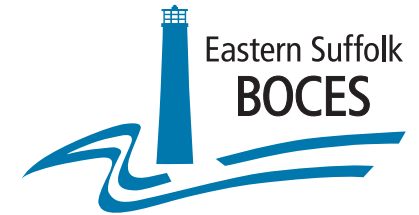

## Integrated Learning Outcomes

Consultation and training are crucial in supporting staff by providing practical strategies in the classroom:

- Consultation provides educators with the support they need to plan and implement programs for student with diverse learning needs in integrated environments
- Prescriptive Training empowers educators and provides them with the skills they need to be successful in an integrated setting.
- On site Consultation provides a more individualized approach to the implementation of skills acquired through training, and assists in the enhancement of collaboration within service delivery teams.

## Prescriptive Training Services

Staff workshops and in-service trainings are designed for both Special and General Education teachers, as well as school related staff working with students with Autism Spectrum Disorders and other Developmental Disabilities. Workshops will be designed to meet the specific needs of program and school environment.
