 - Projected costs for all districts

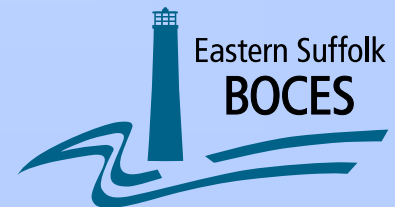

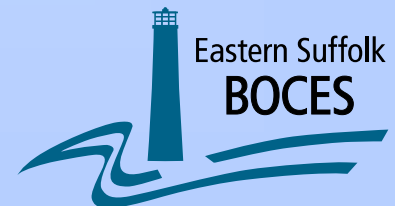

Test Scoring, STEP and LEAP

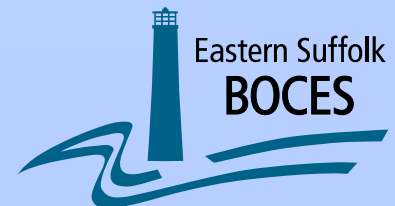
- Scoring NYS Assessments
 - Grades 4, 5, and 8
 - ELA and Math A Regents Exams
 - Grades 3-8 in 2005-2006
 - Most Regents Exams beginning January 2005
- Test Scoring Software
 - 34 regional districts subscribing
 - Lower Hudson RIC
 - Mid-Hudson RIC
- Shared Data Experts
 - Two “experts” in 5 districts now
 - 4 more district requests now pending

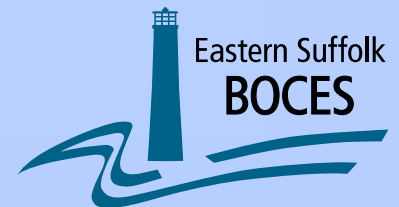

Student Management Systems

- Selection Criteria for Support Services
 - Demand from districts to support at least 2 FTEs (Full Time Equivalents)
 - Application fully operational in more than 1 district for at least 1 full cycle (12 months)
 - Demonstrated vendor responsiveness to SED requirements and user group requests
 - Preferred interoperability with the Data Warehouse
 - Demonstrated vendor willingness to work with BOCES

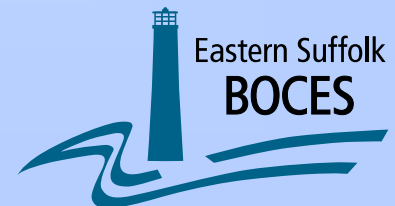
Student Management Systems

- New Service Offerings Under Consideration
 - Power School
 - Presently in use in at least 6 districts
 - Documented performance over at least a full cycle
 - Interoperable with the Data Warehouse
 - Demonstrated vendor responsive to SED requirements, user requests, and BOCES
 - Infinite Campus
 - Recently implemented in 2 districts
 - Performance is under review by RIC for consideration as new service offering

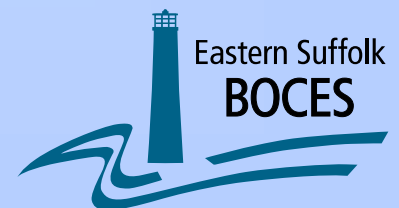

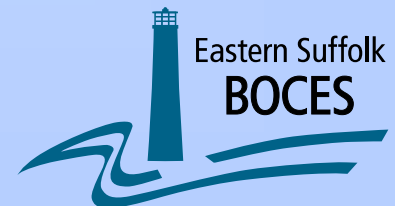


Model Schools

- What is Model Schools?
 - Statewide program supporting teachers and administrators
 - Teacher Integration Specialists provide On and Off site training
 - Support NYS Standards and Assessments through technology integration

Model Schools

- Model Schools Service Offerings
 - Customized professional development for Eastern Suffolk component school district participants
 - Western Suffolk BOCES provides these services to their component school districts
 - Regional professional development workshops
 - Technology Planning services
 - District-to-District Networking
 - Website development support services
 - Grant searching and writing support services
 - Administrative workshops

- Model Schools Service Offerings continued ...
 - Handheld devices (PDA's) training and loaner service
 - Instructional Technology Needs Assessment
 - Rigorous online professional development through Blackboard® with face-to-face components and end-products

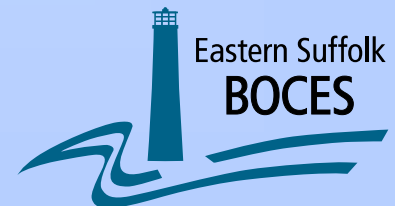


Financial and District Services

 - GASB-34

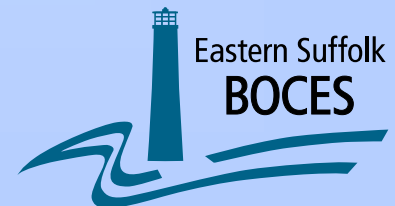
Financial and District Services

- Financial Systems Support/Production Services
 - Training and telephone support for all modules
 - Finance Manager support includes dedicated vendor assistance
 - Finance Manager software and retirement system updates
 - Payroll file transmissions (direct deposit, OMNI, credit union, bank reconciliation files)
 - Check printing and W-2/1099 form printing
 - 23 Regional Districts supported



Financial and District Services

- BOLD-Election Management System
 - Centralized voter registration system
 - Compile voter signature books and budget vote data
 - Produce poll lists and other needed reports
- BOLD-Election Management Services
 - Coordination of electioneering process annual trainings for district clerks
 - 23 Regional Districts supported
 - 15 Out of Region Districts supported

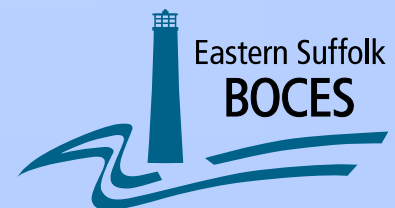

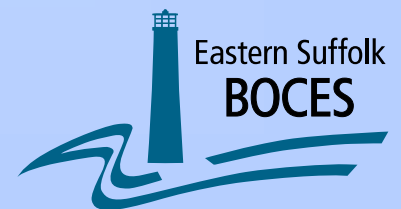
- SchoolDude.com Support Services

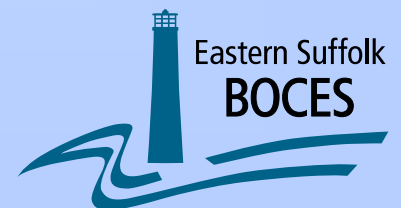
Next Steps ...
