The Charles Duggan Long Island Science and Engineering Fair (LISEF) promotes and supports excellence in scientific inquiry in grades 9-12 by providing a competition for the most advanced high school projects. The participants in this fair have an opportunity to present their presentations virtually, through pre-recorded presentations, to professionals in their subject areas from local universities, scientific institutions and professionals in the field. First place finalists, on condition of final Scientific Review Committee (SRC) Approval, advance to the International Science and Engineering Fair. The participant cost is \$90, and the deadline for submissions is March 1, 2021. Judging will take place from March 5 – 21 and the winners will be posted.
