- ✓ Students will participate in the homework room, where they will be provided assistance with their homework by a certified teacher and counselors.
- ✓ The program will provide refreshments each afternoon consisting of a nutritious snack and milk or juice for each student.
- ✓ Students are provided time for structured recreation. Typical recreational activities available include: use of the school's gymnasium, use of computer labs, use of an established activity room and use of the school's playgrounds.
- ✓ During the course of the year, special enrichment activities and shows will be made available for students to join and participate in.
- ✓ Monthly STEAM-based units are offered for all students to participate in.
- ✓ Transportation to and from the programs is the responsibility of parents and guardians.
