Dear Parent/Person of Parental Relation:

I am writing to inform you of an important procedure regarding delayed openings, early dismissal and school closures due to inclement weather.

If your school district has a delayed opening, students will be excused from ESBOCES for the AM session. However, students enrolled in our afternoon session should report at their normal time.

If your school district is closed but Eastern Suffolk BOCES is open, you have the option of sending your student to the Islip Career Center. You will be required to provide for your child's transportation needs to and from our building. If you choose not to send your child, your child's absence will be excused for the day.

In the event of an early dismissal, your child will remain in our building until transportation can be arranged.
