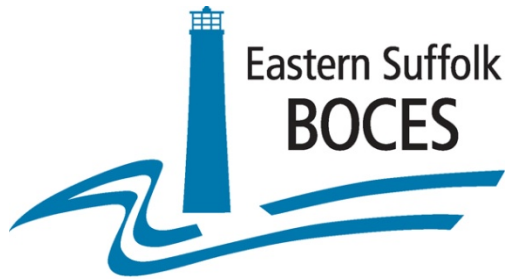

# Goal of ITI-BSE

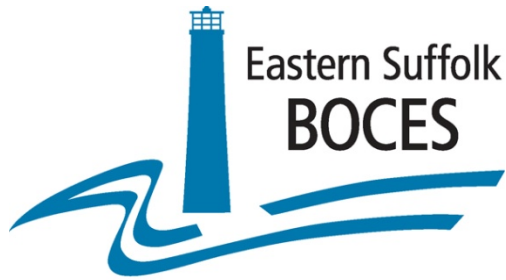
The New York State Education Department P-12 Office of Special Education created the ITI-BSE in 1994 to address the shortage of:

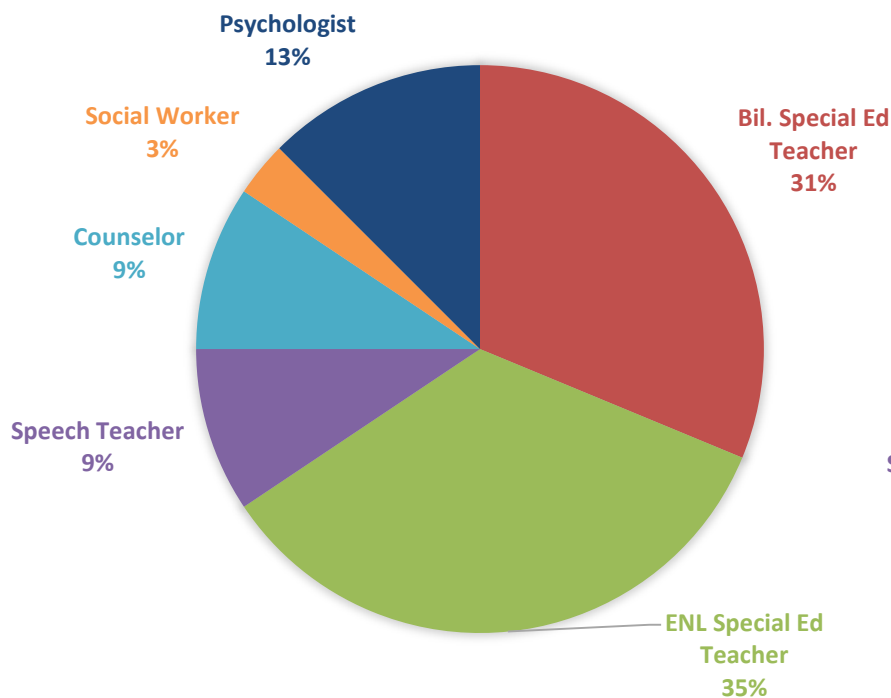
## Participants Breakdown of Assignments



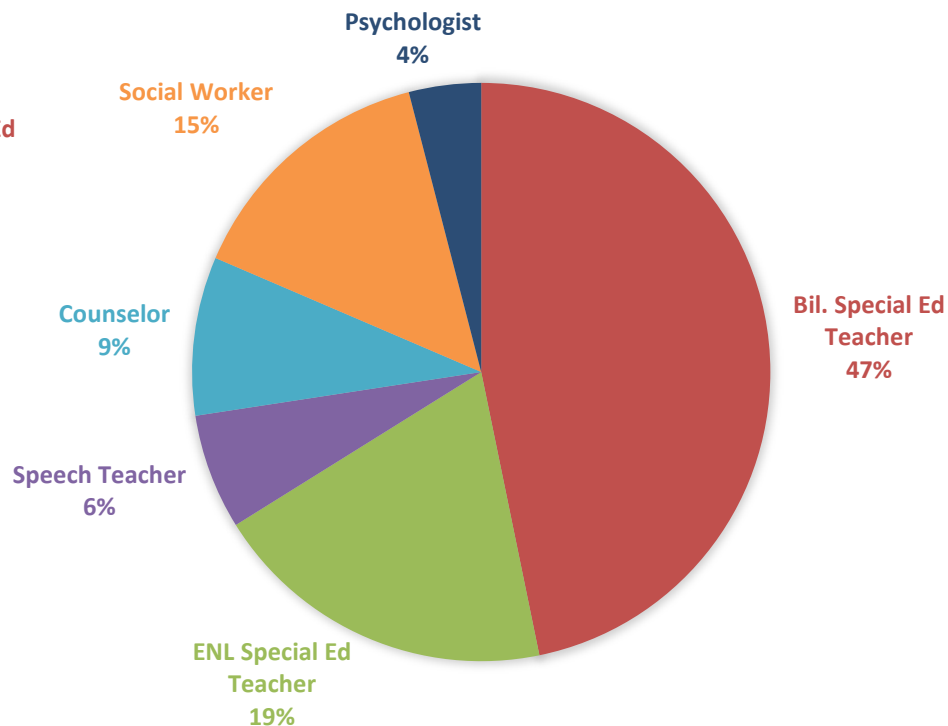

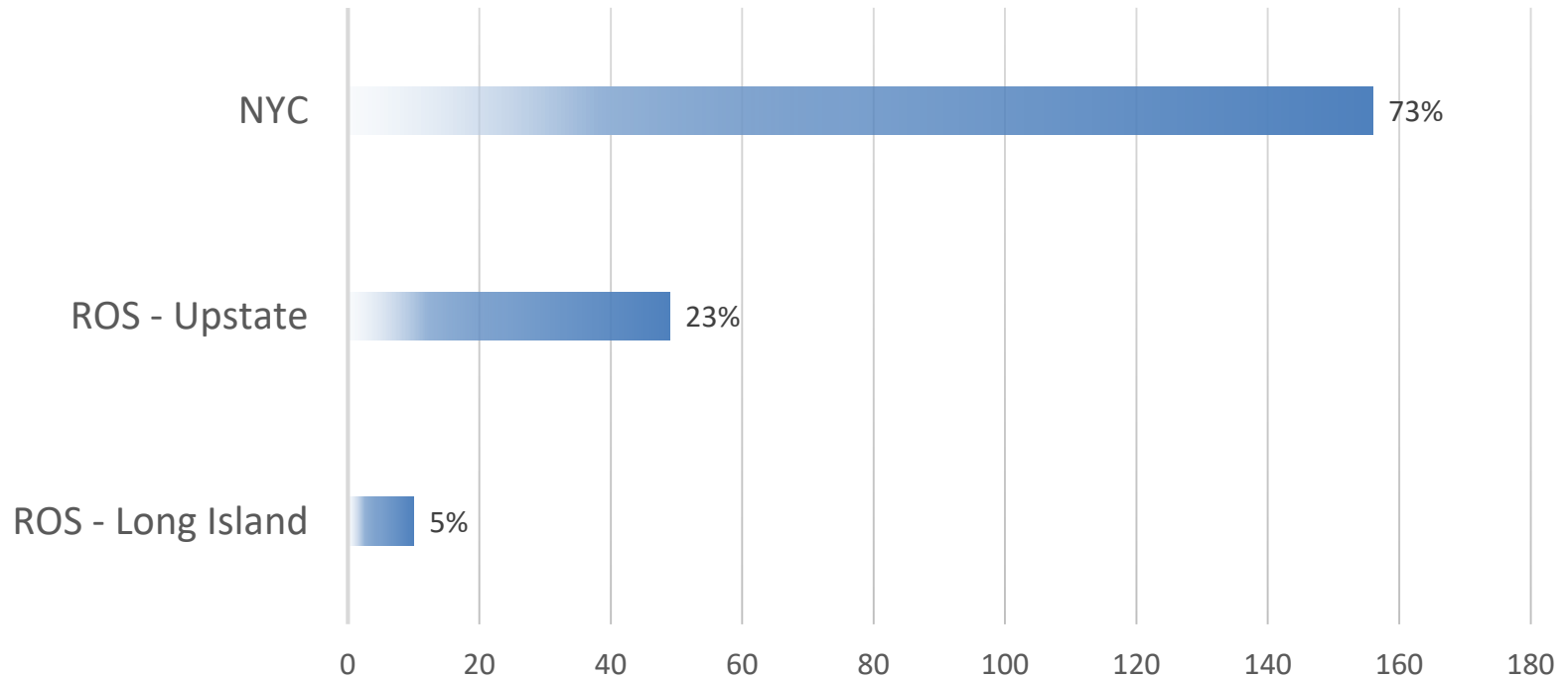


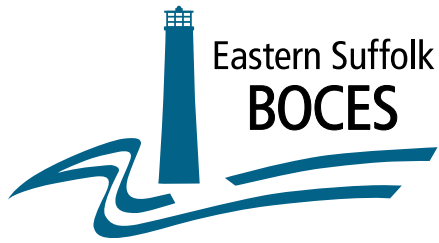
