## An Analysis of Student Performance:

### Identifying Strengths and Opportunities utilizing i-Ready Benchmark Assessment Data and making Comparisons across Multiple Assessment Tools

Many districts rely on the use of Third Party Assessment platforms to monitor student progress. This presentation will provide districts with an opportunity to delve into analyzing the data from i-Ready Reports, and make comparisons among New York State Assessment data and Fountas and Pinnell data to assist in identifying student performance.
