





Q5 Instructional Design - Students acquire, evaluate, and use information effectively through instructional strategies designed to meet learner needs




Q6 Collaborative Planning - Students are encouraged to become lifelong learners through the collaboration and coordination of the library media program with classrooms and the community




Q7 Information Literacy - Students practice critical thinking, know when information is needed, locate, evaluate, and use information effectively, and ask questions about its validity







Q8 Reading - Students have high levels of reading literacy and become independent, life-long reader


Q9 Assessment for Learning - Student learning is assessed in the library media program in collaboration with classroom teachers, utilizing data analysis and Standards









Q11 Inquiry Learning - Independent learners ask questions, evaluate information to improve understanding, and develop social responsibility and strategies for self assessment







Q12 Intellectual Freedom - Students achieve intellectual and social development as responsible, contributing members of society
