Keynote Speaker: Dr. Marsha Tyler-Darling

Committed to Advancing Student Success: Deepening Our Resiliency in Challenging Times

During her opening keynote, Dr. Darling will identify the most pressing challenges student support teams are confronting in their various efforts to provide students with interventions that respond to traumas and crisis. There are a multitude of behavioral and emotional challenges that student support professionals engage with in an ongoing way in an average year, yet the COVID pandemic sharply intensified every level of difficulty faced by young people, as well the professionals who work to promote student well-being and success. Dr. Darling believes that resiliency, grit and determination as among the most important qualities student support team professionals possess and display, particularly during the upending times we have been experiencing, and will propose strategies for deepening the resiliency that will keep student support professionals in the game so to speak, and enable them to continue to advance student success in these extremely challenging times.

Keynote Speaker: Nicole Hockley, Sandy Hook Promise

Know the Signs to Prevent Violence

After her youngest son, Dylan, was murdered in his first-grade classroom at Sandy Hook Elementary School in 2012, Nicole Hockley made a solemn promise to do all she could to protect children from gun violence. She co-founded Sandy Hook Promise with a mission to end school shootings by teaching students and educators to "know the signs" of potential violence and when and how to safely intervene. Join her to hear more about how to recognize the warning signs of a person who may be in crisis and ways to help, as well as no-cost, research-informed programs and practices that are proven to create safer schools.
