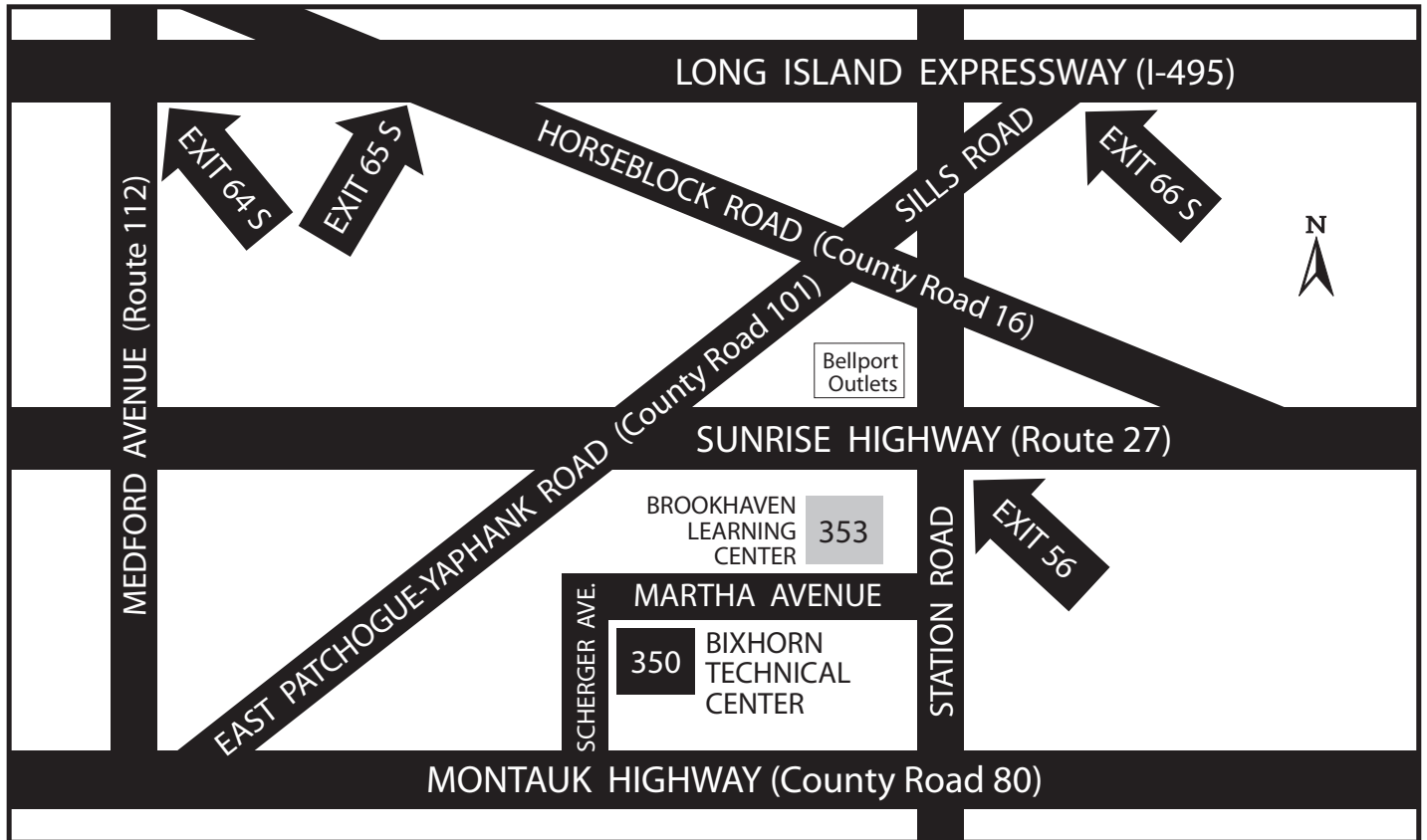

#### **DIRECTIONS**

##### **Via Sunrise Highway (Rte 27):**

Exit 56 (Station Road); proceed south on Station Road; turn right onto Martha Avenue and proceed to the end of the block; entrance to the Bixhorn Technical Center is on the left, at the flagpole.

##### **Via the Long Island Expressway (I-495):**

*From the West:*

Exit 65 South (Horseblock Road–County Road 16); turn right onto Station Road and cross over Sunrise Highway (Rte 27); turn right onto Martha Avenue and proceed to the end of the block; entrance to the Bixhorn Technical Center is on the left, at the flagpole.

*From the East:*

Exit 66 South (Sills Road–County Road 101); turn left onto Station Road and cross over Sunrise Highway (Rte. 27); turn right onto Martha Avenue and proceed to the end of the block; entrance to the Bixhorn Technical Center is on the left, at the flagpole.
